After manning the grill at Brooklyn's famous Peter Luger for twenty years, chef Arturo McLeod brings his culinary prowess to Midtown at Benjamin Steak House. His passionate project, set within the 1903 Dylan Hotel, defines the classic steakhouse in a luscious Beaux-Arts setting rendered elegant and clubby by oak-paneled walls, a vaulted ceiling, and a 10-foot-high roaring fireplace. The professional staff will guide you through the menu, which includes meat-lovers favorites from prime sirloin to extra-thick lamb loin chops, all dry-aged on the premises. Of course, there are lobster tails, along with several other nice seafood options. Make sure to save room for dessert; 13 different sweets are all available with a dollop of homemade Schlag.
